8th to 17th March 2024 9 full days + stay-in

A small-size exclusive group work with Tottori University students to examine social-cultural issues by field visits to local communities, Japanese agencies and Japanese companies in Klang Valley, as part of global leadership training for *both* Japanese and Malaysian students.

Conditions

- Able to stay together and conduct group works throughout the 9-day program from 8-17 March 2024, 9.00am to 5.00pm everyday + staying in without interruptions.
- Able to attend Online Sessions (16/2, 21/2, 28/2). 90 minutes per session.

Expenses

- Accommodation and transportation fees are waived, but food expenses are NOT covered

Selection

- Six (6) participants will be selected
- Shortlisted applicants will be called for an online interview
- This program is limited to undergraduate students in FEM, UPM only

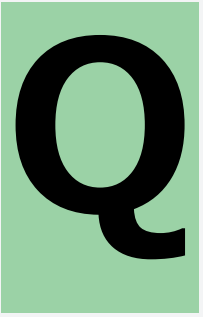


What is TU-UPM Program “Teuta’24”?

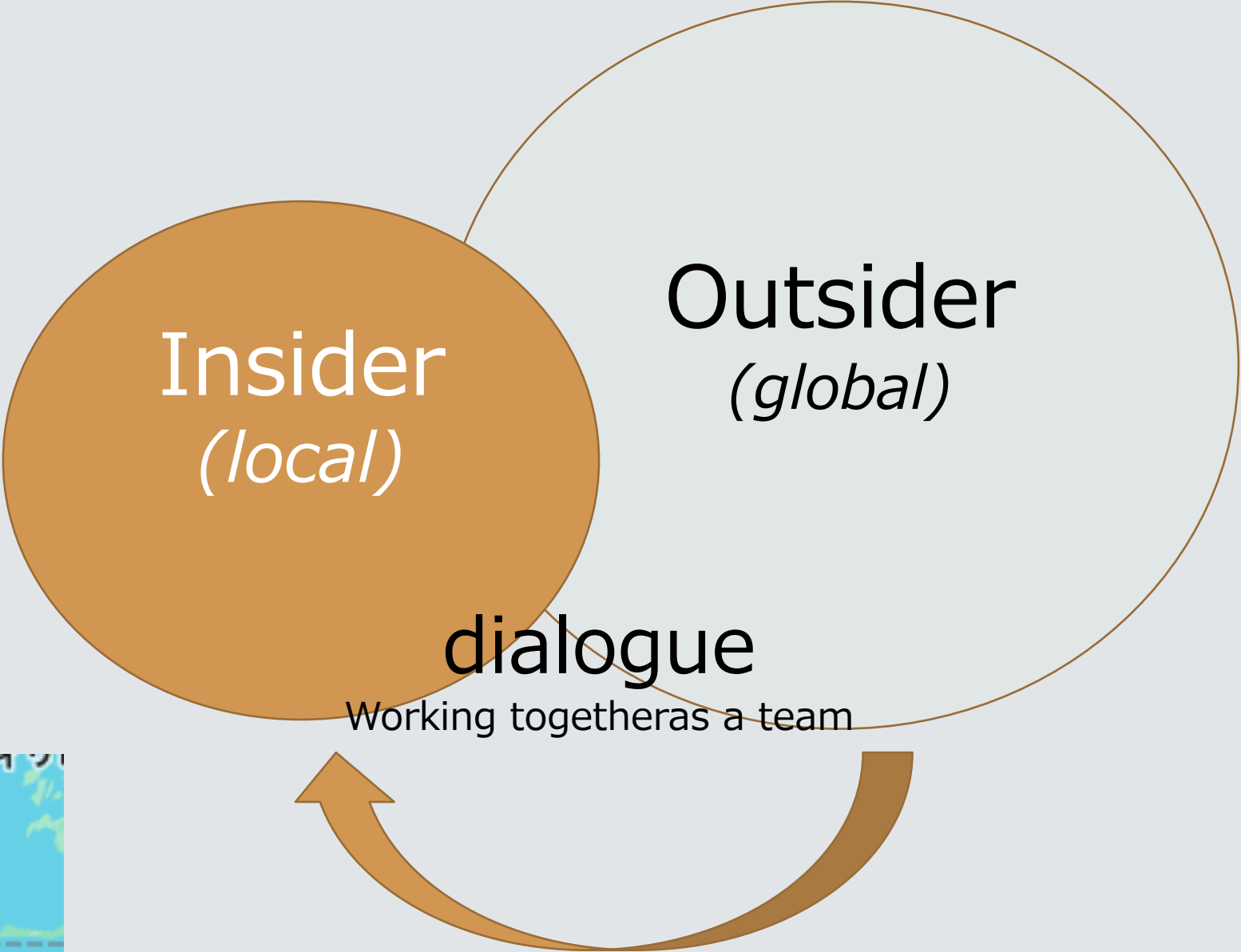

How different is this Program from other exchange programs?



- An **equal participation and contribution in learning** between the students of the host and guest universities; that it is designed for both students of Japanese and Malaysian universities.
- An approach of collaborative learning that looks into the substantial and **real issues of society and industry**;
- that we expect the undergraduate students to work cross-culturally to come out with **creative ideas for the solution of problems**.

(Note: Language skills in Japanese is not a criteria)



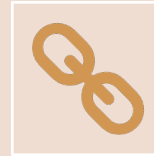
