What is TU-UPM Program “Teuta’24”?

A short-term student exchange program as part of the regular collaboration between *Tottori University, Japan* and *Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM, FEM)*.

It is a 9-day program by selected TU students to Malaysia to conduct group work with selected students from UPM.





How different is this Program from other exchange programs?



- An **equal participation and contribution in learning** between the students of the host and guest universities; that it is designed for both students of Japanese and Malaysian universities.
- An approach of collaborative learning that looks into the substantial and **real issues of society and industry**;
- that we expect the undergraduate students to work cross-culturally to come out with **creative ideas for the solution of problems.**

Different from an ordinary expository-typed exchange program, the Program addresses the needs for cross-border learning as stipulated by OCED and has the following principles as its targeted “education ideal” (<https://www.oecd.org/education/skills-beyond-school/39169515.pdf>)

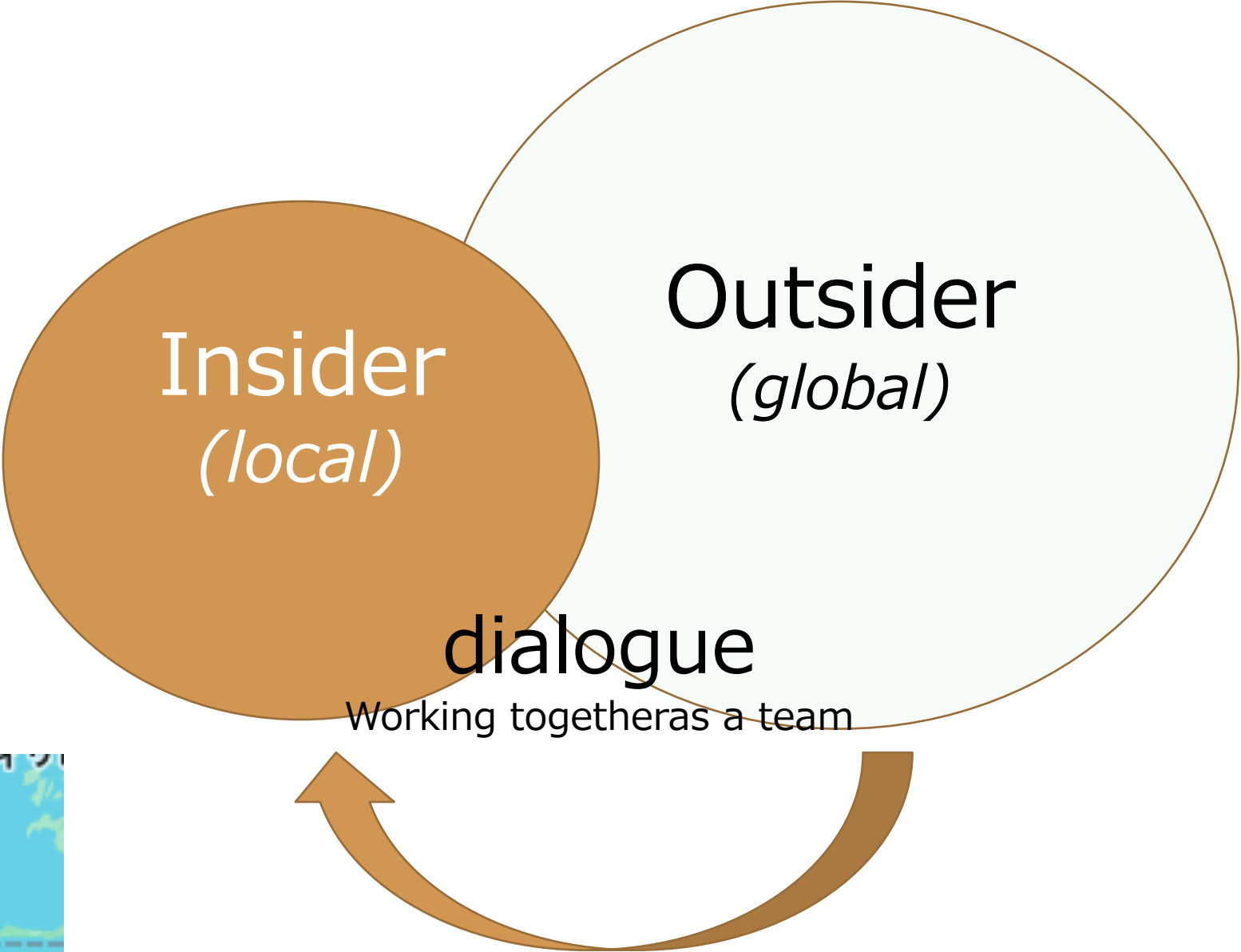

- Able to attend Online sessions (16/2, 21/2, 28/2). 90 minutes per session. Time to be announced.
